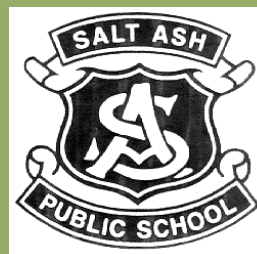

ParentsPlease Note.....Any notes that are distributed at school (including the Newsletter) are available on the School Website.... This should be the first place to go instead of P and C Facebook Page. Any notes handed out are kept in trays or with individual class teachers for children to collect when they return to school. The current Term Four Calendar has been attached to the Newsletter and is also available on the School Website....if you just google Salt Ash Public School it will take you to our Website !!

The School is in the process of introducing Skoolbo for students to use at home...it is similar to other programs that are around. Students will shortly receive a letter with their log in names to be able to access Skoolbo at home.

REMINDER. We have had a spate of students leaving the school with other parents or traveling on a bus without letting the office or the Staff know. We ask, out of courtesy and respect, that parents either:

- Inform the School in writing that their child is leaving the school with another parent or by an alternate means of transport;
- Contact the Office and inform the school or at the very least let the classroom teacher know.

Severe Allergies...we have students enrolled at Salt Ash Public School with severe allergies, in particular latex and products containing latex. These include silicone wrist bands and loom bands. We also have students with a peanut allergy. Our aim is to eliminate, as much as possible, any products containing latex or peanuts from the school

environment. I ask for your assistance in relation to any products containing latex or peanuts... that they not to be brought onto school grounds.

Reminders for Parents

- The car park at the back of the school is for STAFF only and should NOT be used by parents for student safety reasons.

- Requesting Teacher Interviews

Parents wishing to organise an interview with a member of staff are asked to complete a Teacher Interview Request Form. These are available at the front office and from our Website.

Appointments

Parents are reminded that if they have any issues or concerns please contact the school as soon as possible to discuss them. In the first instance please make a time for a phone or face to face interview with the staff member you wish to talk with. Do not come to school especially just prior to the school day commencing expecting to see a member of staff **without a PRIOR appointment.**

Parents are **AGAIN** reminded that our school uniform is **BLACK SHOES**. The School Uniform policy has been uploaded to the School Website.

Nudie Food Tuesday - parents and students are reminded that we are encouraging **ALL** students to bring their 'nude' food to school each and every Tuesday.

Aussie Five Fair Rules....

Parents and students also need to be aware that there are some circumstances in the classroom and in the playground where students can be placed **IMMEDIATELY** on Amber or Red Alert should the behaviour or the circumstances warrant. Dangerous or aggressive or disrespectful and non-compliant behaviour can move straight to Amber or Red if deemed appropriate by the staff in the classroom or on playground duty.

All students know our Aussie Five Fair Rules and what is acceptable behaviour in the classroom and the playground. They are also aware of the consequences for not 'sticking to the rules'

Traffic Light reminders

- Green...warning
- Amber ...Time out in the Classroom or in a buddy Classroom ...with a note sent home and the behaviour recorded electronically.
- Red ... time out of the classroom with a buddy class and a note sent home informing parents of the appropriate time out given at school.
- Parents are also reminded that students remain out of the playground until the behaviour note is returned.

Lions BBQ first Saturday of the each month at the front of Coles.

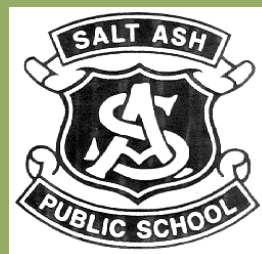
Tilligerry Men's Shed...near the Tilligerry Pool.
