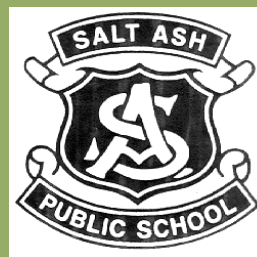

Principal's Report
