Kiss and Drop zone

Kiss and Drop Zones are designed for your convenience and for your child's safety. Designed for quick entry and exit, these zones minimise congestion and risk when used properly by all parents and carers. These zones operate under the same conditions as no parking zones, which means you may stop to drop off or pick up children for a maximum of 2 minutes. You're required to remain in, or within 3 metres of your vehicle. Please be mindful of these zones when picking up and dropping off your children. Rangers are patrolling these areas during school times.



Please also remember that students are only to be dropped and picked up from the front gate (Salt Ash Ave) and the bus bay gate. The back carpark gate will be closed for the safety of our students. A teacher will be available to walk bike riders through if necessary.

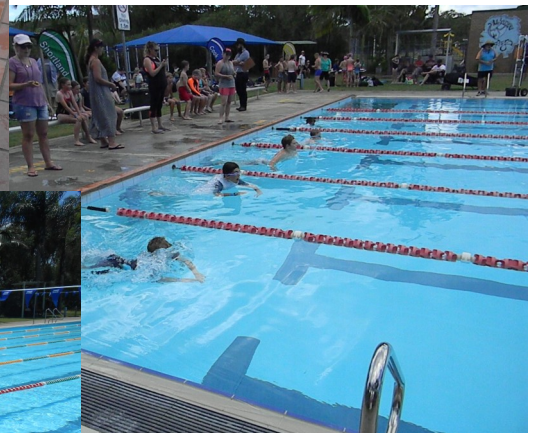
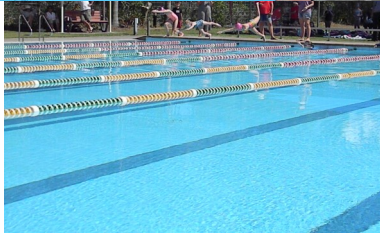
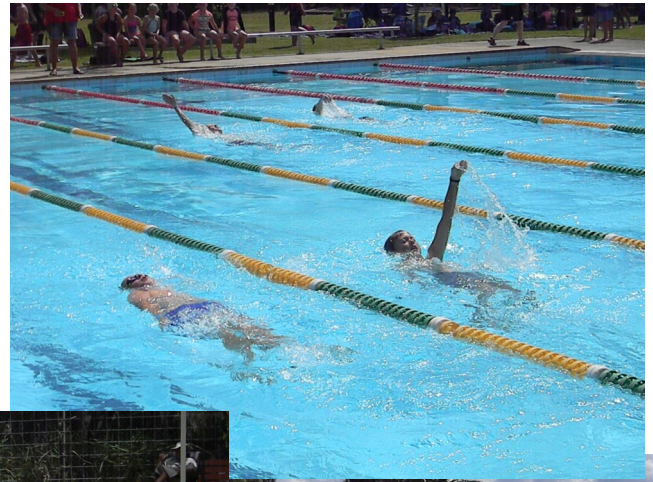
